On behalf of Israeli President Reuven Rivlin, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, Israeli Ambassador to the United States Ron Dermer, and the people of the State of Israel, I would like to extend our deep gratitude to you, the Alabama Legislature, and the State of Alabama for your strong and unequivocal support as expressed through the historic resolution SJR27 – formally recognizing Jerusalem as the eternal undivided capital of Israel, and affirming the U.S. Embassy move.
